# Department of Sanskrit and Lexicography Deccan College Post-Graduate and Research Institute (Deemed University) Pune

The Department of Sanskrit and Lexicography has designed the syllabus of M.A. in CBCS pattern. As per this pattern core papers are compulsory, and core elective papers are optional. Students will select one of the papers from the core elective ones. Open elective paper can be taken by any student of any of the three departments of the University. There are four semesters of the M.A. course of Part I and Part II, each of which has two semesters, and the total number of semesters is four. Total number of papers is sixteen, each of which has five credits. Each Semester has twenty credits of its four papers, and total number of credits is eighty in all four semesters of the M.A. Course.
